Dear Pastor and Church,

We are not happy that they have chosen to take another path and will always welcome them to join back with us, but neither will we apologize for what the Bible teaches nor soft-sell it for the sake of people's feelings.

We may have lost a few people, but we have already gained too. Two of our members, Devin and Viki invited Ava Grace into this world a few weeks ago. We have two other ladies, Anita and Maša, who are also pregnant and set to deliver in the coming months. **Please pray for these ladies and their pregnancies and little Ava Grace who will be dedicated to the Lord in the coming weeks.** It's one way to grow a church. We'll keep trying to expand on that growth with your prayers and support.
