I ended the last letter with a list of names. One of those names was Roman. Roman is a friend of one of the men in our church and they happened to meet each other. Roman was really struggling and quite honestly was about to take some serious steps about ending his struggles. Samo encouraged him and then introduced him to me. We have talked many times since then and although Roman has not yet become a believer, just last week he told me that he wants to be but still has some lingering doubts. This is a huge step to overcome and we ask that you **continue to pray for Roman; that God would really open his eyes to His offer of peace.**

As many years as we have been here in Slovenia, I am still shocked at times about how God works. I was contacted by a missionary in Germany a few weeks ago about a young man here in Slovenia who had reached out to him. He introduced me to him through email and I later reached out to Vid myself. He agreed to meet me at a public library and in our first meeting we talked for about two hours. He explained his spiritual journey to me and how he was open to learning more about the Bible. This is rare coming from a senior in high school but he is quite excited to meet to talk more. **Pray for Vid; that God would give him clarity about how to have a real relationship with Him through Jesus.**

To continue the story of Vid and our first meeting, as we talked, I got this sense that somebody sitting at a table was listening to our conversation. I was not at all loud, it was a library after all, but as we both got up to leave, a young man who was sitting across from us stopped me and said, "I'm sorry, but I was listening to your conversation and I was wondering if I could ask you some questions." I tried not to let it show that you could have knocked me over with a feather because this never happens here. Of course I said yes. David is a skeptic but something in him would not let this opportunity to talk to a Christian pass without approaching a stranger in a library. We talked another hour and a half about his questions. **Please pray for David. He has some very serious challenges in his life but I just know that God wants to do something in his life.**
